Kindergarten

Fall is here! It is an exciting time of the year. The brisk cool air gives the students lots of energy, and they have been working hard learning a lot. In writing, the students have begun to practice writing complete sentences using a capital letter for the beginning word and ending the sentence with a period. Of course, the students also strive to leave spaces between each word. Please continue supporting your child by reviewing what we have worked on. Also, read frequently to your child. Read, Read, and Read some more! In math, the students are working on number sense using the numbers 1 to 20.

1st and 2nd Grade

First grade students are learning basic strategies to read, and there is still a need to practice for each student. Please have your child practice their sight words that have been sent home so far, as well as any reading passages that are sent home. Second graders are reading more every day. Please encourage your child to read at home every day. Second graders will be learning about Ancient Greece and working on vowel sounds. In math, first graders will continue with adding and subtraction within 20 and begin graphing. Second graders will continue to work on place value as well as addition and subtraction with regrouping. Students will spend time learning about Thanksgiving, which will include the study of past and present times as well as focusing on the Native American contribution to Thanksgiving.

3rd, 4th and 5th Grade

Welcome back! It has been so nice to see the students in person! Please make sure your child is working in Acellus on their virtual days. Third grade will be working on multiplication and division in math and text features/kinds of text in ELA. Fourth grade is finishing multiplication and division and starting fractions in math, reading dramas in ELA, and learning about weather and the water cycle in science. Fifth grade is moving on to dividing with double digits in math. In social studies, they will begin learning about the American Revolution. Students will also begin narrative writing and exploring ecosystems in science.

Middle School

We are so glad to see everyone who is back for in-person learning! Since we have returned to campus, Middle School has been focusing on staying safe while at school and setting up routines based on State guidelines for safety. In addition, we have practiced and reinforced the expectations for student work while they are learning virtually from home: 1) Students should have a dedicated work space that is quiet and free from distractions - this includes cell phones and other electronics; 2) Students should begin their day by going into their Google Classroom Homeroom and responding to their attendance question by 9:00 am; 3) They should check and respond to school emails, as well as check for new posts in all Google Classrooms. 4) Once those tasks are complete, students may begin working on their assignments in Acellus and Google Classroom.

Students find more success if they follow a consistent schedule and work in each of their core subjects (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies) every day. The school week is Monday through Friday – even if students are only on campus for 2 days out of the week, they should still be doing schoolwork online during their virtual days. All students have required online meetings on their virtual days, the days and times for which are in their schedules, with reminders posted daily in Google.
