You may receive an Arizona state tax credit of up to \$800 (married and filing jointly) or \$400 (married and filing separately, single taxpayer, or head of household.)

But, any amount less than \$800 (married) \$400 (single) still qualifies

If you make your direct contribution to Boys & Girls Clubs of the Valley, or Mesa Arts Academy, it must be received prior to your tax filing.

***Your child does not have to attend MAA for you to support the tax credit.*
